Lesson:



Students will learn about Ms.Ruby Bridges and the sacrifices she made to help us integrate schools and change the world. It starts with a brief introduction to Black History Month.

- <u>Black History (It's Yours) | Black History Month Rap Anthem | Animated Music Video</u> Play as an introduction to Black History Month.
- <u>Black History Song | Gracie's Corner</u> Gracie sings a great song in honor of Black History Month.
- <u>I am the Dream | Black History Songs for Kids</u> After watching the video, ask the children if they recognize anyone from the video. Ask the children what their dreams are.
- <u>Sesame Street: Arrested Development Sings Pride</u> Play this song about having pride.
- <u>Circle Time with Miss Ruby & Jessica | Cartoon Network</u> Play the video. After ask the children what they remember about Ruby Bridges. Ask the students how they can be like Ruby Bridges.



Create Your 'Proud of Me' picture, (10-15 minutes)

Pass out the activity pages and coloring materials to students Have students create a picture of themselves doing something that they are proud of like reading a book, doing addition or helping a friend. Ensure that students are thoughtful and prepare to share their work with the group. Here are some songs to enjoy while you work. Change the World Song and Love Can Change the World"

Closing Community Circle (5-10 minutes)

In the final minutes allow participants to share their Proud of Me portrait.
